7 pvt colleges to come up

GUWAHATI, March 13 – The State Government has accorded its sanction for setting up seven private colleges till date. These are RJ Degree College (arts & commerce), Guwahati; Swadeshi Degree College (commerce), Guwahati; Ananda Ram Borooah Academy Degree College (arts), Maryam Ajmal Women's College (science), Nagaon; National Education Foundation (science), Shree Bharati College (arts), Dibrugarh; and Indreswar Sharma Academy Degree College (arts & commerce), Dibrugarh. This was revealed by Education Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma in a written reply to a question by Utpal Dutta (AGP) today.
